Dear Attendees,

We are looking forward to seeing you at Utility Perspectives 2021 in Charleston, SC. As the symposium approaches, we wanted to share the COVID-19 safety protocols that we will have in place. The safety of our employees, customers and communities remains Quanta's highest priority, and we are committed to providing all attendees a safe environment.

Venue information:

- Utility Perspectives 2021 will be held at The Hotel Bennett in Charleston, SC. You can access the hotel's commitment to well-being policy here: <https://www.hotelbennett.com/covid-safety>.
- The symposium will take place at The Gaillard Center, in the Grand Ballroom, which is 13,137 square feet. The meeting arrangements in the ballroom allow for physical distancing between guests, based on CDC recommendations. Instead of tables, individual tech chairs will be utilized in the Grand Ballroom. - The Sunday reception, Monday dinner and all symposium lunches will be held outdoors. All venue layouts ensure guests will be able to practice physical distancing.

On-site supplies:

- Masks and hand sanitizer will be provided at all meeting and event locations.
- 15-minute COVID tests will also be available at all meeting and event locations, for those attendees that would like to get tested.

Before you travel:

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the World Health Organization (WHO), Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and your local health authority.
- Adhere to all government-issued travel requirements.
- Stay home if you feel sick or if you have been exposed to someone who has either tested positive or is exhibiting symptoms consistent with Covid-19.
- Stay home if you have tested positive for Covid-19 or are awaiting results of a Covid-19 test.

Vaccines & testing:

- All staff and attendees must show proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours prior to their arrival to Utility Perspectives.
- All staff and attendees will take a daily health assessment test prior to entering the facilities and will be provided an onsite 15-minute COVID-19 test if needed.

CDC recommendations:

- Quanta is closely monitoring the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and World Health Organization's statements and latest recommendations regarding the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) cases.
- Our full Covid-19 protocols will be finalized and sent to all attendees prior to the conference.
